The Children's Centres provide services for families with at least one child under the age of five. Our services are universal so anyone can access them. We offer non-judgemental, impartial, friendly advice and we are always there for you! We run sessions for children and their carers daily throughout the week.

## Family Support

The Rise Trust offers a Parenting Academy where parents/carers can access courses which includes, Parenting, ante & post natal and challenging behaviour. The trust works in partnership with Family Learning to offer other courses such as English, ICT or Maths. Health Visitors run weekly clinics in each children's centre.

## Youth work

The RISE Trust employs a Youth Worker to provide mentoring to young people at schools in Chippenham. We also work with a team of volunteers to run an open access youth club & a youth cafe.
