## **Breast Feeding Peer Supporter:**

Were your or are you a breastfeeding mum who would like to train to offer support and advice to new and expectant mums through our Mum2Mum groups. Groups run across the area each day of the week and we are looking for volunteers to support our groups in Chippenham and Corsham. Once trained this placement requires a weekly commitment of 2 hours a week.

<u>Family Visiting Service:</u> (Chippenham, Calne, Malmesbury, Cricklade, Wootton Bassett) Could you use your parenting skills and experience to support a local family in need? Volunteers visit families in their own homes to offer support, guidance or just a listening ear. This placement requires a weekly term time commitment of between 2-3 hours.

Stay and Play: (Ladyfield Church Hall, Chippenham)

Can you spare a couple of hours to support our volunteer led Stay and Play Group for parents/carers of pre-school children? This group runs year round on Tuesday mornings 10am – 11.15am. The group is led by a team of volunteers who operate on a rota basis.

<u>Youth Club</u>: Riverside, The Olympiad Leisure Centre, Chippenham A youth club run by our youth worker to offer a safe place for the Year 7 and above group to meet. Volunteers support our youth workers and help with activities. This group runs on Wednesday and Friday evenings.

<u>Bumps to Babes:</u> Cricklade Children's Centre. A volunteer led group supporting expectant parents or parents with babies under the age of 1. Mondays 11am - 12.30. The group is led by a team of volunteers who operate on a rota basis.

<u>Stay and Play</u>: Cricklade Children's Centre. A volunteer led stay and play group for parents/carers of pre-school children. Tuesdays 1.30-2.30. The group is led by a team of volunteers who operate on a rota basis.

## **Contact Centre:** (Chippenham)

A contact centre provides a safe, friendly and neutral place where children of separated families can spend time with one or both parents and sometimes other family members. This is a child-centred environment that provide toys, games and facilities that reflect the diverse needs of children affected by family breakdown. Volunteers in the Child Contact Centre need to be impartial, confidential, caring, tolerant, sensitive and discreet. The Contact Centre operates on the 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday each month all year round and requires a commitment of 3 to 4 hours per Saturday. We have a team of contact centre volunteers and cover operates on a rota basis.

<u>Cook (to cover absence)</u>: (Chippenham) We are looking for a volunteer with experience within catering who is able to cover at short notice the preparation and distribution of a cooked meal at lunchtime for our Early Excellence Centres. This would be between 15-25 meals dependant on the centre.

Not all placements require a regular weekly commitment please ask for further details.
