RISE Children's Centres provide services for families in the North Wiltshire area with at least one child under the age of five.

We offer non-judgemental, impartial, friendly advice and we are always there for you! Our services have been developed in response to community needs.



The Rise Trust works with families and children to help them to get back on their feet and to deal with life's challenges in ways which make things better for them and their children.

We do this by providing:

- Parenting courses
- Family Visiting Service
- Money/ debt advice
- Access to health advice

- Ante-natal and Post-natal Support inc breastfeeding
- Access to drug & alcohol advice and support

What Rise does..... Child Poverty

It comes as a surprise to many people living in North Wiltshire that there are children living here who are hungry and cold.

We provide food parcel vouchers in times of emergency and support parents so to make the most of their money. We also help ensure they are on the correct tariffs and benefits.

Parenting Support

Parenting can be a challenge and demanding for the majority of parents at some point in their child's life.

Our 'Parenting Academy' offers a range of courses that improve family life, relationships and help children grow into happy healthy little people. These courses have become a lifeline to parents.

Our Young Parents Workers can make a difference to these families by supporting parents one to one and through a weekly drop in group. Young parents are taught everything they need to know to nurture a happy healthy baby. They are then encouraged to return to college and gain the qualifications they need to go into work.



Our RISE pre-schools are situated in Chippenham. These offer a variety of carefully thought out areas both inside and outdoors, that are well resourced to excite our 2-5 year olds in their early learning.

One to One Family Support

All families can experience times of difficulty and struggle with life's challenges. This makes it really difficult to cope with bringing up children, who may as a result, struggle with routines, boundaries, managing emotions and meeting their developmental milestones.

One to One outreach support offers relaxed, non-judgemental and confidential support at home. We work in partnership with parents and, where appropriate, other professionals. We empower and enable families to overcome their challenges making life better for the whole family.

Mentoring in schools

Children can be in need of someone to talk to especially if they are in a busy household.

Trained volunteers meet children in primary schools weekly to offer a listening ear. Sometimes children do not have someone who will just listen and support them. This service is free to schools. If you would be interested in volunteering for this please call 01249 464008.



Child Contact Centre

Sometimes children become separated from family members for lots of different reasons.

The 'Child Contact Centre' is a safe, friendly and neutral place where children from separated families can spend time with their non-resident parent.
