



2025: 84% of young people gave us 8 or more out of 10 for our service

YOUNG PEOPLE

We reach approximately 270 young people/week, mentoring 15 individually/week. Weekly pop-ups (4 secondary schools) see hundreds of YP/week. Empowering our young people is key so we train young youth volunteers, supporting them in further training including apprenticeships.

RISE PRE-SCHOOL - Parental survey 2025 showed 100% are happy with the all aspects of our provision.

Ofsted 'good' in 2023 - "Staff know the children very well... Potential issues are identified early on... Parents are fully involved..." "It's a lovely warm and welcoming place for the children to attend pre school. The staff team are amazing very enthusiastic, and really get to know the children on a personal one to one level. MENTOR ME

In 2023-2024 10 cases were fully completed (6 months' minimum support) and **90% of the children doubled scores** from their baselines We supported 15 families
(19 children) in academic year 2023-2024 and enabled 7 families to organise their own arrangements following court procedures. In
2025 100% of families moving on have given our service a 5-star rating.





PATCHWORK PROGRAMME - Aimed to support parents and children rebuild relationships after trauma. During our programme pilot on average children made 9.8 points and parents 6.2 points progress from their starting point.

VOLUNTEERING - The RISE Trust encourages people to volunteer and we have 35 volunteers supporting across our preschool, contact centre, youth service and mentoring service. "We enjoying coming in so much - the children are fantastic and we really appreciate how welcome everyone has made us."

YOUTH VOLUNTEERING - Currently we have 16 young youth volunteers. Two previous young volunteers are now undertaking their apprenticeships with The RISE Trust!



YOUTH MENTORING - Currently developing our assessment processes using The Soul Record. Young people say...

"Meeting N, I was able to get angry, swear and be myself, without being judged . I needed this so much, she understood me. "

"When I have my 1-1 mentoring in school, I can reflect on the morning and feel refreshed and ready for the rest of the day."

"When I first got referred to mentoring, I felt a little nervous as I thought it would be awkward but as soon as I met my mentor, it was like being at youth group and I felt so at ease . We spoke and laughed, and was able to offload to her of all the things I would be embarrassed to talk to anyone else about." "Giving the children a little bit of 'We' time has enabled them to work through their anxieties and has helped to mem to work through men and confidence before moving on to improve self-esteem and confidence before moving on to "The teachers in pre-school are warm, patient, and nurturing, fostering a safe and engaging environment that allows children to thrive."
