Jan 2026: 92% of young people gave us 8 or more out of 10 for our service

RISE PRE-SCHOOL - Parental survey 2025 showed **100%** are happy with the all aspects of our provision.

Our Early Years Advisory Teacher says - "Staff interact positively with children and support them in their child-initiated endeavours."

YOUNG PEOPLE's FUEL programme -

In the holidays we also provide the FUEL programme for Wiltshire Council. It is described as 'Fantastimazing' and 'exciting'.

100% of those questionned gave us 8 or more out of 10 for the FUEL programme

MENTOR ME - In 2024-2025 11 cases were fully completed (6 months' minimum support) and **100% of the children doubled scores** from their baselines



Mentor - "The pupils have grown in confidence and the feedback from the school staff reassures me that they have made great progress. The programme is tailored to each child's needs but to see their development is the reason that I enjoy the role so much."

PARENT SUPPORT ADVISOR -

"I am incredibly grateful to my PSA - she helps me to understand my child's behaviours and makes plans that helps us all."

"I have always found it difficult to have a good relationship with the school, it has been really helpful having my PSA, as she acts as a bridge between us.

PATCHWORK PROGRAMME - Aimed to support parents and children rebuild relationships after trauma (19 children). During our programme pilot on average **children made 7.5 points and parents 5.5 points progress** from their starting point. We measure how many make 2 points or more progress - 77% of parents and 84% of children made our progress target.



VOLUNTEERING - The RISE Trust encourages people to volunteer and in December 2025 we had 38 volunteers supporting across our pre-school, trust board, youth service, contact centre and mentoring service. This totalled 2603 hours in 2025 - an equivalent of nearly £31,800 in gifted time.

"It is an absolute joy just spending time with the pre-schoolers. As part of our adoption journey volunteering at the RISE Trust has helped to build my confidence around young children. The Staff have been welcoming and warm."

YOUTH VOLUNTEERING - Currently we have **15** young youth volunteers across north Wiltshire. Previous young youth volunteers have successfully undertaken their apprenticeships with The RISE Trust!



YOUTH MENTORING -

Our 2025-2026 data so far shows that 83% of mentees have made 2+ points progress in one term (introduced September 2025).
